<b>Race 1</b> SPORTSBET GREEN TICKS (275+RANK) 2:37 pm 500m Maiden	A pre-race sample was taken from Tiger Stripes.  Greysynd Fever was quick to begin.
<b>Race 2</b> NATIONAL GREYHOUND ADOPTION MTH (275+) 2:54 pm 425m Maiden	Snow Renaissance – New declared weight of 27.5kg, last raced at 28.8kg.  A pre-race sample was taken from Mcivor Morgan.  Jilliby Mish, Limit Miss and Autumn Angel were quick to begin.  Autumn Angel (checked and fell on the first turn), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a wrist and whip injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.
<b>Race 3</b> BENDIGO ADVERTISER (275+RANK) 3:14 pm 425m Maiden	Pursuant to GAR 75(6), Kennel attendant Ms J. Hooke did not act in any official capacity that may have in any way affected the outcome of this event.  Pursuant to GAR 75(6), Kennel attendant Mr D. Elliot did not act in any official capacity that may have in any way affected the outcome of this event.  A pre-race sample was taken from Literally.  Saxon Raider (lost ground in the home straight), underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.  A post-race sample was taken from Showgirl Kara – the winner of the event.
<b>Race 4</b> HIP POCKET BENDIGO (275+RANK) 3:29 pm 425m Grade 7	Man Of Action – Late scratching at 2:12pm due to weight variation (GAR 101). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Trainer, Mr Jack Clarke was fined \$100.  A pre-race sample was taken from Hillbilly Lexi.  Mo City (racing manners in the home straight), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re-examined following race 6. Mo City was found to have a whip injury. A 5 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative Mr Bruce Jacobs regarding Mo City's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Mo City was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Jacobs pleaded guilty to the charge. Mo City must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
<b>Race 5</b> AVARD CIVIL (275+RANK) 3:47 pm 425m Grade 5	Swanny River – Late scratching at 1:40pm on the advice of the On-Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to a left wrist injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.  A pre-race sample was taken from Blue Bale.  Semantic Queen was quick to begin. Hillbilly Lass was slow to begin.

<b>Race 6</b> AG TYRES & WHEELS (275+RANK) 4:04 pm 425m Grade 5	<p>A pre–race sample was taken from Lala Speed.</p> <p>Zippy Wiesman was quick to begin. Lala Speed was slow to begin.</p>
<b>Race 7</b> GRAY’S BENDIGO (275+RANK) 4:22 pm 500m Mixed 6/7	<p>Pursuant to GAR 75(6), Kennel attendant Mr A. Blake did not act in any official capacity that may have in any way affected the outcome of this event.</p> <p>A pre–race sample was taken from Aerobic Ice Age.</p> <p>Tornado Jack was slow to begin.</p>
<b>Race 8</b> SHIMA SHINE AT STUD (275+RANK) 4:39 pm 500m Grade 5	<p>A pre–race sample was taken from White Shiraz.</p> <p>Tantangara Girl and White Shiraz were slow to begin.</p>
<b>Race 9</b> CAMPBELL’S COMMENTS (275+RANK) 4:57 pm 425m Grade 7	<p>A pre–race sample was taken from Lektra Sam.</p> <p>Lektra Sam and Cruising Amy were quick to begin.</p> <p>Lavish Showgirl (checked and lost ground on the first turn), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left wrist injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Following the event, Lektra Sam collapsed in the catching pen. The greyhound was pronounced deceased by the On–Track Veterinarian. Routine samples were taken, and an autopsy will be conducted in accordance with GAR 43.</p> <p>Supplementary Advice: 15/5/24 on Lektra Sam - Following a post-mortem examination the likely diagnosis was circulatory collapse and sudden death following acute haemothorax and cardiac failure. No prohibited substances were detected in the samples.</p>
<b>Race 10</b> PETER BROWN CUSTOM HOMES (275+RANK) 5:14 pm 425m Grade 6	<p>We Are South – Late scratching at 2:11pm due to non–arrival (GAR 86 and LR 39). A 28 day stand down period was imposed. Ms B. Kinder informed Stewards that she had a vehicle breakdown on–route to the track. Stewards advised Ms Kinder that evidence of the breakdown will need to be submitted, to the satisfaction of Stewards, within 72 hours of the occurrence that caused the non–arrival. The matter will be re–evaluated upon receipt of this evidence.</p> <p>A pre–race sample was taken from Sandy’s Lara.</p>
