Hillbilly Nova was slow to begin.</p> <p>Hillbilly Nova - checked and lost ground first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re–examined following race 12. Hillbilly Nova was found to have a right satorious muscle injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to representative Ms J Wilson regarding Hillbilly Nova’s overall performance - non competitive throughout. After hearing submissions from Ms J Wilson, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Hillbilly Nova unsatisfactory. Hillbilly Nova must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
