Stewards charged Ultraflex under AGRR 80.2 for failing to pursue the lure with due commitment on the third turn. After taking evidence from Handler, Peter Riley (representing Trainer - George Dailly), acting on their own observations and taking into account the injuries sustained to the greyhound, the Stewards invoked AGRR 82.1(d) in lieu of AGRR 80.2 and will require the greyhound to perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) before any future nomination will again be accepted.
