Hook Shot was slow to begin.</p> <p>Hook Shot visibly eased and turned its head to the inside approaching the winning post, underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury found. Stewards spoke to Mr David McKenzie regarding Hook Shot's racing manners approaching the winning post. Mr. McKenzie declined the option to have the greyhound re-examined. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Hook Shot was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. McKenzie pleaded guilty to the charge. Hook Shot was suspended for 28 days at Warragul and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>

In accordance with GAR 122, the Stewards requested Mr. Handley to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Darnum Diva in the event, which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event.</p>

Greyhounds that were boxed (1,3,5,7), were removed from the starting boxes and all greyhounds underwent an examination by the On-Track Veterinarian, and subsequently passed fit to race in accordance with GAR 110(7). The race was delayed by approximately 7 minutes whilst this occurred. The race commenced at 5:26pm.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Ms Kelleigh Smith regarding the unnecessary delay in boxing Wild Rover in this event. A warning was issued to Ms. Smith pursuant to GAR 105 (9). Wild Rover will also be boxed first in future events in accordance with GAR 106.</p>
