In arriving at this decision, Stewards took into careful consideration the injury assessment combined with Mr Interligis's understanding of the greyhounds apparent limitation at the distance of this event. Stewards will monitor Inter Black Fire's future events and Mr. Interligi stated he will nominate the greyhound for shorter distances.
