Race 1

14 RACES TODAY

10:36 am 390m Tier 3 - Maiden The Stewards were advised that the track was medium harrowed on 3rd October 2024.

Paw Trinny was quick to begin. Vista Why and Paw Harris were slow to begin. A post-race urine sample was taken from Bona Vista - winner of the event.

Race 2

SWEET NETTY'S CATERING

10:51 am 390m Tier 3 - Maiden Paw Waitara and Cherry Time were quick to begin. John Boy was slow to begin.

Baby Shaka (lost significant ground in the home straight) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re-examined following race 9. Baby Shaka was found to have left and right gracilis strains and a left groin muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. Michael Bewley and Mrs. Debbie Bewley regarding the performance of Baby Shaka in the event. After hearing submissions from Mr. & Mrs. Bewley, viewing the available race footage, and taking into account the injuries sustained, Stewards took no further action.

SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI

11:06 am 390m Grade 5 T3 Car Wash Chaos - Late scratching at 10:19am on the advice of the On-Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) after the greyhound was found to have vomited. A7 day stand down period was imposed

Sam's Boy, Rie Bale and Harbour Lights were quick to begin.

Race 4

A1 SIGNAGE 11:21 am 390m Grade 5 T3

Rapidfire Layla was quick to begin. Sandy's Lara was slow to begin.

Tinker Goose (faltered approaching the first turn and subsequently tailed off) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right gracilis muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.

Following the running of the event, Stewards inspected the track and deemed it suitable for racing.

Elsa Jay and Paw Penelope collided turning off the back straight resulting in both greyhounds falling. Both greyhounds underwent post-race veterinary examinations:

- Paw Penelope was found to have left scapula fracture. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.
- Elsa Jay was found to have no apparent injury.

Jungle Fireball was quick to begin. Belle Extra and Jams Nimble were slow to begin.

Belle Extra underwent a post–race veterinary examination at the trainer's request and was found to have a right gracilis injury and a right toe injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted.

Gogo Skye – Late scratching at 10:06am due to weight variation (GAR 101). Gogo Skye is not permitted to compete for 10 days in any other Event. Trainer, Mr. Suwit Bunchusri, was fined \$100.
