Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, After The Bell was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. O'Keeffe pleaded guilty to the charge. After The Bell was suspended for 28 days (1st offence) at Warragul and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
