A post-race urine sample was unable to be taken from Panama Rebel, a post-race blood sample was subsequently taken – placed 4th in the event.

Stewards issued a warning pursuant to GAR 81(1) to Handler Mason Koffman, after he lost effective control of Paw Jolyn near the stir-up yard prior to the running of this race. Paw Jolyn underwent a pre-race examination by the On-Track Veterinarian and was passed fit to race.
