3:19 pm 390m Maiden $\label{eq:miss} \mbox{Miss Fixated - Late scratching at 2.27pm due to weight variation (GAR 101). Miss Fixated is not permitted to compete for 10 days in any other Event. Trainer, Mr Y Rishon was fined $100.$

Heart To Heart was quick to begin.

Heart to Heart underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right deltiod muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative Mr G Turnbull regarding Heart To Heart's racing manners approaching the first turn (by reason of injury). Mr G Turnbull pleaded guilty to the charge.
