Following the event, Braemar Audrey collapsed in the catching pen. The greyhound was pronounced deceased by the On–Track Veterinarian. Routine samples were taken and a necropsy will be conducted in accordance with GAR 43.

Supplementary Report – 19/12/24 - A necropsy was conducted on Braemar Audrey which was pronounced deceased by the On– Track Veterinarian following the race. The likely cause of death was acute cardiovascular failure.
