At the commencement of kennelling, the outside temperature was 25 degrees and the kennel temperature was 17.2 degrees. Stewards continually monitored the temperature at the venue, as per the GRV Hot Weather Policy.</p> <p>Outlawed – New declared weight of 33.6 kg, last raced at 32.0 kg.</p> <p>Flying Mckeon (galloped on and severely checked at the 50m mark) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have an abrasion over the left fore accessory carpal bone. A 3 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Outlawed (lost ground from the 150 metre mark) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left wrist sprain. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>A post-race urine sample was taken from October Rain - the winner of the event.</p>

A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards interviewed trainer Mr. Derek Faulknall in relation to the bona fides of the withdrawal of Zinlan Plodder from this race. Stewards reminded Mr. Faulknall of his responsibility to ensure his greyhounds are fit to race prior to the appointed scratching time. Further, Stewards require a veterinary certificate of fitness to be produced before any further nominations are accepted for Zinlan Plodder, in accordance with GAR19(3)(w).</p> <p>The start was delayed by approximately two minutes due to operational activities.</p> <p>Foxy Freckles, Point The Finger and Agon Caramel were quick to begin.
