A 14 day stand down period was imposed. - Wendy's Joy was found to have no apparent injury. <p>Cordova was very slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent injury. Stewards spoke to Mr. Matthew Clark regarding Cordova's actions in the starting boxes and at box rise. After hearing submissions from Mr. Clark, viewing the available race footage, and having their own observations, the Stewards issued a warning. Stewards will monitor the box manners of Cordova in future events.</p> <p>A post-race urine sample was taken from Amron Sammy - the winner of the event.</p>

Acacia Rocket was found guilty suspended for 28 days (2nd offence) at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
