<b>Race 1</b> 13 RACES TONIGHT 6:27 pm 450m	In accordance with the GRV Hot Weather Policy, this meeting was deemed 'Heat Affected'. At the commencement of kennelling, the outside temperature was 33.1 degrees and the kennel temperature was 19.0 degrees. Stewards continually monitored the temperature at the venue, as per the GRV Hot Weather Policy.
Maiden	Pursuant to the GRV Hot Weather Policy, Stewards dispensed with two requirements prior to kennelling, meaning greyhounds were no longer required to remain on course for the specified time, and that the parading of greyhounds was to occur, as the outside temperature had decreased to a reasonable level.
	Panama Rebel and Maraine Piper were quick to begin. Belair Nomad and If Only were slow to begin.
	Daisy Marjen (turned head outwards in the home straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re-examined following Race 3. Daisy Marjen found to have no apparent injury.
	Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr D.Jensen regarding Daisy Marjen's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Daisy Marjen was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Jensen pleaded guilty to the charge. Daisy Marjen was found guilty and suspended for 28 days (1st offence) at Warrnambool and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
	If Only (checked and fell soon after the start) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a spike wound to the left dew claw. A 3 day stand down period was imposed.
	A post-race urine sample was taken from If Only – unplaced in the event.

Stewards spoke to trainer Ms K Boyle regarding the greyhound pulling up prior to the return gate and failing to enter the catching pen. After hearing evidence from Ms K Boyle, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards issued a warning.

Race 7 PADDY WANTS PATS 8:40 pm 450m Grade 7	Paw Isabelle was slow to begin. Trainer Mr D.Jensen failed to appear at the kennels by the appointed time to retrieve and prepare Moraine Max for racing. A fine of \$200 was issued pursuant to GAR 97(2).
Race 8 BROAD TREE CARE 8:59 pm 450m Mixed 4/5	Tornado Tahlia and Aston Zingara were quick to begin. Marais Bale and Freddy Deeds were slow to begin.
Race 9 WOOD MOTORCYCLE & MOWER 9:24 pm 390m Grade 7	A pre–race urine sample was taken from Top Flight. Nova Mia was slow to begin.
Race 10 rideforlucy.com.au 9:43 pm 390m Grade 7	A pre-race urine sample was taken from Condah Express. Moraine Grace was quick to begin. Aston Katy raced wide in the home straight. Stewards held the All Clear in order for Stewards to review the positioning of the lure in the vicinity of the home turn, with reference to GAR 109(2). After reviewing all available footage and acting on their observations, Stewards were comfortably satisfied that no runner was neither advantaged or disadvantaged so as to affect the outcome of the event. Therefore, the variance was permitted in accordance with GAR 109(2), and the All Clear was given on [7 – 8 – 2 - 4].
