## Race 1 13 RACES TODAY (300+RANK)

Maiden

A pre-race urine sample was taken from Bindy Blazer.

Whipping Along, Nirranda Gracie and Aston Vanessa were slow to begin.

Inga Freddy (checked turning into the home straight and lost ground) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury and abrasions to the right metatarsals. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Race 2 SPORTSBET GREEN TICKS (300+RANK) 3:27 pm 390m Maiden	A pre-race urine sample was unable to be obtained from Nova's Fern, a post-race blood sample was subsequently taken.
	Aston Sovereign was quick to begin. Tindal Jet and Belair Red were slow to begin.
	Tindal Jet (faltered in the back straight and subsequently tailed off) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.
	Peachy Keen (checked turning into the home straight and lost ground) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have severe pannus to the left eye. Acting under the provisions of GAR 42, Peachy Keen is prohibited from competing in an event until such time as both a veterinary clearance is provided to the satisfaction of Stewards and a Satisfactory Trial is completed, pursuant to GAR 132.

Race 3	A pre-race urine sample was taken from Basement.
MACEY'S BISTRO (300+RANK) 3:45 pm 390m Grade 7	Minh Candy was quick to begin. Squeegee's Ride, Basement and Long Reef were slow to begin.

Race 4	A pre-race urine sample was taken from Rich Flex.
MATKO HIRE (300+RANK) 4:02 pm	Bebop Giblet was quick to begin. Inga Leah was slow to begin.
390m Grade 5	Inga Leah (lost ground over the concluding stages) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left back muscle injury and a right front split webbing. A 21 day stand down period was imposed.

Race 5 BROAD TREE CARE (300+RANK) 4:21 pm 450m Mixed 6/7 Alice Express – Late scratching at 2:38 pm on the advice of the On– Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to a laceration to the right thigh. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

A pre-race urine sample was taken from Aussie Flame.

Moraine Max and Aussie Flame were quick to begin. Timmy Time was slow to begin.

Running Sinker underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have injuries to the left back muscle and left pectineus. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative Ms. Nadine Jack regarding the racing manners of Running Sinker in the back straight. After hearing submissions from Ms. Jack, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, a warning was issued.

Moraine Joker (checked turning off the back straight and subsequently fell) underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported.

Aussie Flame underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left back muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative Mr. Cameron Taylor regarding the greyhound pulling up prior to the return gate and failing to enter the catching pen. After hearing evidence from Mr. Taylor, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations,

	Stewards issued a warning. Furthermore, pursuant to GAR 122, the Stewards requested Mr. Taylor to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Aussie Flame in the event, which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event. Due to Moraine Joker falling and returning the wrong way down the back straight, the lure was pulled up sharply (after going through the catching pen apron) to avoid a collision with the oncoming greyhound.
<b>Race 6</b> PADDY WANTS PATS (300+RANK) 4:44 pm 450m Grade 5	A pre–race urine sample was taken from Cawbourne Gia. Dr. Forest and Bruno's Encanto were slow to begin.
Race 7 EDWARDS ELECTRICAL (300+RANK) 5:02 pm 450m Mixed 6/7	A pre–race urine sample was taken from Thermal Smoke. Pocket Mouse was slow to begin.
<b>Race 8</b> RIDE FOR LUCY (300+RANK) 5:21 pm 450m Grade 5	A pre–race urine sample was taken from Kel Of Kintyre. Shaka Big Chief and Lektra Layla were quick to begin. Miss Your Kiss and Moraine Marco were slow to begin.
Race 9 WOOD MOTORCYCLE & MOWER (300+RANK) 5:40 pm 390m Grade 7	A pre–race urine sample was taken from Aston Tafari. Heather Bale was slow to begin. Heather Bale (checked turning off the back straight and subsequently fell) underwent a post-race veterinary exmaination - no apparent injury was reported.
Race 10 FIND US ON FACEBOOK (300+RANK) 6:00 pm 390m Grade 6	A pre–race urine sample was taken from Aston Accord. Saint Jayden and Lorelle Soldier were slow to begin.
Race 11 SPORTSBET SET A DEPOSIT LIMIT (300+RANK) 6:19 pm 390m Grade 5	A pre–race urine sample was taken from Two Hat Pat. Two Hat Pat and Killer Bee Cammy were quick to begin. Two Hat Pat (lost ground turning off the back straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left flexor tendon injury. A 28 day stand down period was imposed.
Race 12 ONE MORE RACE TO GO (300+RANK) 6:37 pm 390m Grade 5	Ulna - Late scratching at 6:30pm on the advice of the On– Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to a left sesamoid injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. A pre–race urine sample was taken from Seance Sam. Full Speed Ahead, Black Bow and Seance Sam were quick to begin.

Race 13 WARNNAMBOOL RACE 13 (300+RANK) 6:53 pm 390m Grade 5 A pre-race urine sample was taken from Arabian Princess.

Squiggly Papa and More Boost Rico were slow to begin.

Arabian Princess (checked turning off the back straight, faltered and subsequently tailed off) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have injuries to the right calf, right back muscle and right flexor tendon. A 28 day stand down period was imposed.

Satisfactory Trial:

Just In Time - Fail to Chase – Field of 5, Distance: 390m, Weight: 28.6kg, Box 2, Placed 2nd, Time Run 23.558 – Comment: Not Cleared - did not meet time standard.

Glad All Over - Fail to Chase – Field of 5, Distance: 390m, Weight: 28.0kg, Box 8 – Comment: Not Cleared - pulled up turning off the back straight.
