Sweet Cannelloni (checked turning out of the back straight and lost ground in the home straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have left gracilis and right hamstring injuries as well as a spike wound on the right hind. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

Race 11 SENNACHIE AT STUD 9:28 pm 400m Grade 5	This Train - New declared weight 27.9kg, last raced at 26.7kg. Frantic – Stewards were satisfied with the boxing of the greyhound and removed the boxed first endorsement for future events, in accordance with GAR 106.
Race 12 SPORTSBET NOBODY DOES IT EASIER 9:44 pm 400m Grade 5	Harley was quick to begin. Celtic Bouy and Free Falling were slow to begin. Fill Your Boots (turned its head outwards in the home straight) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left long head triceps injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr. David Crawford regarding Fill Your Boots' racing manners turning into the home straight and in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Fill Your Boots was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Crawford pleaded guilty to the charge. Fill Your Boots was found guilty must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted. Due to the dead heat for third place, the judge briefly semaphored the incorrect numbers of 3-5-4-7. This was corrected to 3-5-4/1 before the All Clear was given.
