Stewards withheld the 'all clear' to ascertain if any greyhound had been disadvantaged. After viewing all video footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards were satisfied that no greyhound had been affected and the 'all clear' was posted.</p> <p>A post-race urine sample was taken from Paw Verity - the winner of the event.</p>

July She Lied was slow to begin.</p> <p>Eternia (racing manners in the home straight), underwent a post-race veterinary examination. It was reported that the greyhound was found to have a spike wound to the left front toe. A 3 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Representative - Ms. M Parfett-Oliver, regarding the racing manners of Eternia in the home straight. After hearing submissions from Ms. Parfett-Oliver, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, the Stewards issued a warning to connections.</p>
