<p><b>Race 2</b> rideforlucy.com.au 6:52 pm 390m Maiden</p>	<p>A pre race urine sample was taken from Aston Tempest. Aston Tempest was quick to begin. Hideaway Clyde was slow to begin.</p>
<p><b>Race 3</b> A1 SIGNAGE 7:15 pm 390m Grade 5</p>	<p>Car Wash Chaos was quick to begin. Even Chance was slow to begin. A post race urine sample was taken from Bombarda Maxima - the winner of the event.</p>

After reviewing all available footage and acting on their observations, Stewards were not comfortably satisfied that the incident had no effect on the outcome of the race. As such, pursuant to GAR 110, the event was declared a 'No Race'. All bets are to be refunded. The weights recorded for the greyhounds are void and do not count for the purposes of the weight rule at the greyhounds' next start. The event was then abandoned, with prizemoney to be split evenly between the greyhounds that competed.</p>
