Race 1

CRYMELON KENNELS

10:08 am 410m Maiden In accordance with the GRV Hot Weather Policy, this meeting was deemed 'Heat Affected'. At the commencement of kennelling, the outside temperature was 25.3 degrees and the kennel temperature was 16.4 degrees. Stewards continually monitored the temperature at the venue, as per the GRV Hot Weather Policy.

Race 2

SPORTSBET HT1 10:27 am

410m Mixed 6/7 Heat Paw Sakakibura and Black Beauty were quick to begin.

A post-race urine sample was taken from Paw Sakakibura - the winner of the event.

Panadero Ruby - underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported. Re-vet declined.

Stewards spoke to trainer Mr G George regarding Panadero Ruby's racing manners on the home turn and in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Panadero Ruby was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr G George pleaded guilty to the charge. Panadero Ruby was suspended for 28 days (1st offence) at Horsham and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Husky Sara Lee - underwent a post–race veterinary examination at the trainer's request – no apparent injury was reported.

Race 3

SPORTSBET HT2 10:45 am 410m Mixed 6/7 Heat Mystic Firefly – Late scratching at 9.14am on the advice of the On–Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to a laceration to the left thigh. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Brielle was quick to begin. Noah's Best was slow to begin.

A post-race urine sample was taken from Brielle - the winner of the event.

The announcement of the All Clear was delayed for the Stewards to review the race footage after a bird was positioned on the track on the home straight and walked off as the greyhounds approached. After viewing the footage and acting on their own observations, the Stewards were comfortably satisfied that no greyhounds were materially affected so as to affect the outcome of the event. The All Clear was posted.
