Fred Rose (racing manners on the home turn and in the home straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury reported. Stewards spoke to Mrs. Sharon-Lee Chignell regarding Fred Rose's racing manners. After hearing submissions from Mrs. Chignell, viewing the available race footage, and having their own observations, a warning was issued. In arriving at this decision, Stewards formed the view that whilst Fred Rose had raced ungenerously on the inside of Reaper entering the home straight, Stewards were not comfortably satisfied that Fred Rose's racing manners constituted a breach of GAR 124. Indeed, Stewards were not comfortably satisfied that sufficient evidence existed to make out the case that Fred Rose had either turned his head or visibly eased at this point of the race.

Pursuant to GAR 122, the Stewards requested Mrs. Chignell to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Fred Rose in the event, which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event.
