Stewards spoke to Mr. Sheldon Hamilton regarding Lady Calamity's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, Lady Calamity was charged with marring. Mr. Hamilton pleaded not guilty to the charge. Lady Calamity was found guilty and suspended for 28 days (2nd offence) at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post-race urine sample was taken from Dark Miracle – the winner of the event.</p>
