<p><b>Race 2</b> TOONGABBIE LODGE 7:25 pm 515m Grade 6</p>	<p>Snitch Adams was slow to begin.</p> <p>Lucky faltered turning into the back straight, causing Paw Barton to be severely checked and resulting in both greyhounds falling. These greyhounds underwent post-race veterinary examinations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Lucky was found to have a right hock fracture. Lucky was humanely euthanised.</li> <li>- Paw Barton was found to have a left hip injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.</li> </ul> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr. Darryl Connor regarding She's Extreme's racing manners entering the back straight. After hearing evidence from Mr. Connor, viewing all the available race footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards took no further action. In arriving at this decision, Stewards took into consideration that Lucky and Paw Barton fell in front of She's Extreme and the effect this incident would reasonably have had on the racing manners of She's Extreme.</p> <p>Following the running of this event, Stewards inspected the track turning into the back straight and deemed it suitable for racing.</p>

<p><b>Race 3</b> DOWNLOAD THE WATCHDOG APP 7:43 pm 515m Grade 5</p>	<p>Just Divine – New declared weight of 30.6 kg, last raced at 32.0 kg.</p> <p>A pre-race urine sample was taken from Just Divine.</p> <p>Bebop Jazz was quick to begin.</p> <p>Just Divine (checked and lost ground turning out of the front straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right monkey muscle injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Fill Your Boots (visibly eased in the home straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a spike wound to the left fore. A 7 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. David Crawford regarding Fill Your Boot's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Fill Your Boots was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Crawford pleaded guilty to the charge. Fill Your Boots was suspended for 28 days (1st offence) at Sandown and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post-race urine sample was taken from Bebob Jazz - the winner of the event.</p>
