At the commencement of kennelling, the outside temperature was 31 degrees and the kennel temperature was 17.8 degrees. Stewards continually monitored the temperature at the venue, as per the GRV Hot Weather Policy.</p> <p>Pursuant to the GRV Hot Weather Policy, Stewards dispensed with two requirements following kennelling and prior to Race 1, meaning greyhounds were no longer required to remain on course for the specified time, and that the parading of greyhounds was to occur, as the outside temperature had decreased to a reasonable level.</p> <p>Acting in accordance with the GRV Lightning and Thunderstorm Safety Procedure, racing was suspended at 6:08pm due to continuous lightning strikes.
