Race 2 SPORTSBET HT2 5:39 pm 435m Maiden Heat	Fail In Style – Late scratching at 1:59pm when Mr. Taylor Thornton reported the greyhound to be lame. (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted. Hammer Rose and Be Gracious were slow to begin.
Race 3 MONACELLARS 5:57 pm 435m Grade 5	A pre-race urine sample was taken from Be Rugged. Fantastic Zohan, Abundant Lumens and Betsie Bale were slow to begin.
