Nana's Rebel, Seven Of Nine and Kraken Honey raced wide in the home straight.

SPORTSBET HT2 3:27 pm 390m Maiden Heat Paw Kattia was quick to begin. Run Cliff Run was very slow to begin.

Darra Sapphire underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Ms. Jenny Weber regarding the greyhound pulling up prior to the return gate and failing to enter the catching pen. After viewing the available race footage, and acting on their observations, Stewards issued a warning.

Crowned Best (checked turning off the back straight subsequently pulled up) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a flexor tendon injury on the right fore. A 28 day stand down period was imposed.

RANK) 4:04 pm 390m S/E Veteran Spring Ammo and Bear Lee Crime were quick to begin. Cocktail was slow to begin.

Bern's Ability began to lose ground turning off the back straight and continued to cede ground for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed right triangle muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Mr. Thomas Wark advised Bern's Ability would be retired.

A post-race urine sample was taken from Spring Ammo - winner of the event.

GPP LASER3300 4:22 pm 390m Grade 5 A pre-race urine sample was taken from Post The Zipper.

Rapdifire Forest and Post The Zipper were guick to begin.

Stewards conferred with the Judge regarding the margin and finishing times for 3rd and 4th between Rapidfire Forest and Tropic Man. A margin was visible in the photo finish image with the actual finishing time for Rapidfire Forest being 22.4661 compared to 22.4666 for Tropic Man. However, as FastTrack is limited to displaying three decimal places, both times were automatically rounded to 22.467. As such, no margin is displayed in FastTrack.
