#### Race 1

SPORTSBET GREEN TICKS (275+

11:54 am 435m Maiden Parumba Prince – Late scratching at 11:16 due to non–arrival (GAR 86 and LR 39). A 28 day stand down period was imposed.

Henchman and Valencia Lilly were quick to begin. Another Story was slow to begin.

Kilmany Warrior was checked several times on the home turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

Hurricane Elsie raced awkwardly in the back straight, underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

A post–race urine sample was taken from Reckless – the winner of the event.

Supplementary Report – 13/9/24: The 28 day stand down was removed from Parumba Prince after the Stewards were comfortably satisfeid as to the circumstances of the non-arrival.

Got My Mojo was quick to begin. Go See Ian and Tiles And Wine were slow to begin.

Go See lan, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left hindleg triangle injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative Mr. Lindsay Fulford regarding the racing manners of Go See lan in the home straight. After hearing submissions from Mr. Fulford, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, a warning was issued.

Key Pilars lost ground on the first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hindleg triangle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to kennel representive Ms. Claire Jones regarding Key Pilars overall performance in the event. Pursuant to GAR 122, the Stewards requested Ms. Jones to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Key Pillars in the event, which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event.

Supplementary Report – 13/9/24: The 28 day stand down was removed from Parumba Cha Cha after the Stewards were comfortably satisfied as to the circumstances of the non-arrival.

After hearing submissions from Ms. Sultana, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Inter Mary unsatisfactory. Inter Mary must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Furthermore Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted.
