A7 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. Jordan Cooper regarding Crackerjack Reed's racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Crackerjack Reed was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Cooper pleaded guilty to the charge.
