A5 day stand down period was imposed no apparent injury was reported. Red Ed – Stewards were satisfied with the boxing of the greyhound and removed the boxed first endorsement for future events, in accordance with GAR 106. A post-race urine sample was taken from Noctilucent – the winner of the event. Aston Aurelia – Late scratching at 10:51am when Ms Michelle Mallia reported the greyhound to have a illness (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted.

Tat Leah (faltered on the first turn and subsequently tailed off) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a dislocation and ruptured ligament to the right hind toe and a dislocated right hock. A 28 day stand down period was imposed. A post-race urine sample was taken from Kraken Whisky - the winner of the event. Following the running of this event, Stewards inspected the track on the first turn and deemed it satisfactory for racing.

Mr R.Clark informed Stewards that he had a vehicle breakdown on–route to the track. Stewards advised Mr Clark that evidence of the breakdown will need to be submitted, to the satisfaction of Stewards, within 72 hours of the occurrence that caused the non–arrival. The matter will be re–evaluated upon receipt of this evidence. A pre–race urine sample was taken from Jaimandy Frank. Up Hill Shiloh was quick to begin. Lucky Lisa and Judgemental were slow to begin.

Stewards advised Mr Clark that evidence of the breakdown will need to be submitted, to the satisfaction of Stewards, within 72 hours of the occurrence that caused the non–arrival. The matter will be re–evaluated upon receipt of this evidence. Artemis One was slow to begin.
Race 12 ONE MORE RACE TO GO 6:27 pm 450m Grade 5	Rashid - Late scratching at 6:21pm on the advice of the On–Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to dehydration. A 5 day stand down period was imposed. Sha Tin King was quick to begin. On High Alert (marred Buck Shines approaching the home turn) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a laceration to the left hind toe. A 5 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Ms Karen Pitt regarding On High Alert's racing manners approaching the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, On High Alert was charged with marring. Ms. Pitt pleaded guilty to the charge. On High Alert was suspended for 28 days at Shepparton and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
