Fraddam Rock (faltered in the back straight), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have injured the right shoulder muscle and the right triangle. A 21 day stand down period was imposed.

Steeple underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Mr. Patrick Newell regarding Steeple's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, Steeple was charged with marring. Mr. Newell pleaded guilty to the charge. Steeple was suspended for 28 days (2nd offence) at Shepparton and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
