Valencia Lola, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re-examined after race 12 and found to have a right foreleg carpal sprain. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to trainer Mrs Jennifer Gieschen regarding Valencia Lola's racing manners in the back straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Valencia Lola was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mrs Gieschen pleaded guilty to the charge. Valencia Lola must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted

Aussie Can Fly faltered on the first turn and subsequently tailed off, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury. A 21 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race urine sample was taken from Westerly Bale - unplaced in the event.
