Race 1

SPORTSBET GREEN TICKS

(300+RANK) 11:08 am 435m Maiden Tiles And Wine, Soda Turkey and Dr. Nash were slow to begin.

Tiles And Wine contacted the running rail on the first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left wrist laceration. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.

Dr. Nash faltered and lost ground in the home straight, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hind back muscle and triangle injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race urine sample was taken from Archer Nine - the winner of the event.

Race 2

MONACELLARS (300+RANK)

11:27 am 435m Maiden Miss Massage - New declared weight of 30.5kg, last raced at 29.1kg.

Touch My Hand, Pagoda Growler and Trendy Mover were quick to begin.

Miss Massage faltered soon after the start and subsequently tailed off, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re–examined following Race 5. Miss Massage was found to have left hind hamstring and triangle injury. A 21 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race urine sample was taken from Touch My Hand - the winner of the event.

Songkran was severely checked on the first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a lumbo-sacral injury. A 5 day stand down period was imposed.

Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Apple Cherry was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Ms Wilkins pleaded guilty to the charge. Apple Cherry was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race urine sample was taken from Bowie Sunny- the winner of the event.
