<p>Race 1 SPORTSBET SAME RACE MULTI 6:09 pm 390m Tier 3 - Maiden</p>	<p>Blinding Faith – Late scratching at 5:25pm due to weight variation (GAR 101). Blinding Faith is not permitted to compete for 10 days in any other Event. Trainer, Ms. Margery Quick was fined \$100.</p> <p>Pursuant to GAR 75(6), track staff Mr. Shaun Boag did not act in any official capacity that may have in any way affected the outcome of this event.</p> <p>A pre–race urine sample was taken from Crackerjack Lee.</p> <p>Hey Ella was quick to begin. King Ron, Moraine Alfie and Morain Felix were slow to begin.</p> <p>Moraine Alfie (racing manners turning out of the back straight) underwent a post–race veterinary examination – and was found to have a left back muscle injury, left track leg injury and bruising/contusion. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr. Glenn Judd regarding Moraine Alfie racing manners on the turn out of the back straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Moraine Alfie was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Judd pleaded not guilty to the charge. Moraine Alfie was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr. Glenn Judd regarding his conduct during an inquiry. A reminder of responsibilities for detrimental comments was issued pursuant to GAR 165(a).</p>

A 5 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Vista Why (checked and contacted running rail turning out of the back straight) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left tibia laceration. No stand down period was imposed.</p>

Moraine Spike and Lose My Number were quick to begin.</p> <p>A post race urine sample was taken from Reiko Terror - the winner of the event.</p>

A 5 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>A pre–race urine sample was taken from Western Bale.</p> <p>Love ABourbski and Mention were quick to begin.</p> <p>Love ABourbski and Mention raced wide in the home straight.</p>

<p>Race 6 TOWN & COUNTRY LINE MARKING 7:52 pm 450m Tier 3 - Grade 7</p>	<p>A pre-race urine sample was taken from Wardan Jilungin.</p> <p>Sabatini was slow to begin.</p> <p>The announcement of the All Clear was delayed for the Stewards to review the race footage after a bird (plover) was positioned on the track in the home straight and alighted as the greyhounds approached. After viewing the footage and acting on their own observations, the Stewards were comfortably satisfied that no greyhounds were materially affected so as to affect the outcome of the event. The All Clear was posted.</p> <p>Sabatini (checked soon after start and lost ground) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have both left and right shin soreness. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.</p>
<p>Race 7 A1 SIGNAGE (1-3 WINS) 8:07 pm 450m Tier 3 - Restricted Win</p>	<p>A pre-race urine sample was taken from Speedy Khe Sanh.</p> <p>Hard Rotor, Go Now and Belle Extra were slow to begin.</p> <p>Speedy Khe Sanh raced wide turning into the home straight. Jolly Encounter and Hustle Nina raced wide in the home straight.</p>

A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>A post-race urine sample was taken from Pyrenees Prince – the winner of the event.</p>
<p>Race 11 TUDOR ELECTRICAL (2-3 WINS) 9:26 pm 390m Tier 3 - Restricted Win</p>	<p>A pre-race urine sample was taken from Harlow's Boy.</p> <p>Mr. Darren Petersen requested an early race endorsement for More Boost Rico. Stewards approved the request after an extensive examination prior to racing by the On-Track Veterinarian. More Boost Rico will compete in early races until further notice.</p> <p>More Boost Rico was slow to begin.</p>
<p>Race 12 BALLARAT GREYS BINGO EVERY SUNDAY 9:46 pm 390m Grade 5 T3</p>	<p>A pre-race urine sample was taken from Moraine Baloo.</p> <p>Lily Crackers was quick to begin.</p> <p>Lily Crackers (faltered turning off the back straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have left and right back muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.</p>
