	examination and was found to have a right wrist sprain. A7 day stand down period was imposed. Inward Harmony, poor performance, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left hock sprain. A7 day stand down period was imposed.
	Stewards spoke to trainer Mr C Baker regarding Inward Harmony's overall performance. After hearing submissions from Mr C Baker, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Inward Harmony unsatisfactory. Inward Harmony must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted. (Time ran 25.15 - grading time 24.80)
	Spellcaster, poor performance, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right triangle muscle injury. A7 day stand down period was imposed.
	Stewards spoke to trainer Mr C Baker regarding Spellcaster's overall performance. After hearing submissions from Mr C Baker, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Spellcaster unsatisfactory. Inward Harmony must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted. (Time ran 25.36 - grading time 24.80)
