A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr. Colin Baker in relation to the bona fides of the withdrawal of Mustard De Jong from this race. Stewards noted Mr. Baker's comments.</p> <p>Myraid – New declared weight of 31.4kg, last raced at 32.6kg.</p> <p>Lady Teela and Myriad were quick to begin. Sleek Machine was slow to begin.</p> <p>Our Gem (lost ground at the 150m mark) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left back muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. Jason Stemmer regarding Book Of Capers' racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Book Of Capers was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Stemmer pleaded guilty to the charge. Book Of Capers must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
