Race 1

At the commencement of kennelling, the outside temperature was 36.3 degrees and the kennel temperature was 17.9 degrees. Stewards continually monitored the temperature at the venue, as per the GRV Hot Weather Policy.

Isinbayeva was quick to begin. Paw Razor was slow to begin.

It was noted that the muzzle of Glad All Over became dislodged during the running of the event.

Glad All Over- severely checked and stumbled soon after the start and subsequently tailed off. Glad All Over underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left triangle injury. A 14 day

stand down period was imposed.
