At the commencement of kennelling, the outside temperature was 23.3 degrees and the kennel temperature was 17.7 degrees. Stewards continually monitored the temperature at the venue, as per the GRV Hot Weather Policy.</p> <p>Zippering Duffin, Twilight Digger and Flying Nardo were slow to begin.</p> <p>The announcement of the All Clear was delayed for the Stewards to review the positioning of the lure at the winning post, due to the lure losing power shortly after passing the winning post. After viewing the footage and having their own observations of the incident, the Stewards were comfortably satisfied that whilst the lure lost power and decreased in speed, no greyhounds were advantaged or disadvantaged so as to affect the outcome of the Event.
