Meeting Comments

Satisfactory Trial Results

Stewards spoke to Mr. T. Currie, the trainer of Peggy Sable regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Peggy Sable last raced on 8th May 2016. Mr. Currie stated that the greyhound was returning to race after a front left foot injury, being on season and a change of kennel. Pursuant to GAR 77A Peggy Sable trialled over the 300 metre distance from box 1, weight 25.6kgs. The greyhound

was placed 1st, in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 17.28. The greyhound won by a margin of 0.75 lengths. Peggy Sable was cleared.
