Meeting Comments:

Stewards conducted an inquiry into the Non-Arrival of Fetty Wap at the Geelong meeting on the 18th of November 2016.

Stewards heard evidence from the trainer Mrs. Andrea Dailly.

After hearing evidence, Stewards charged Mrs. Dailly in breach of Greyhounds Australasian Rule 86(o) in

that the greyhound Fetty Wap was not presented for an event which in the Stewards opinion was negligent.

Mrs.Dailly pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mrs Dailly guilty as charged and issued a fine of \$500.00 with \$250.00 suspended for 12 months pending no further breach of rule GAR  $86(\circ)$ .

In relation to the penalty Stewards took into account Mrs Dailly's honesty and the time since the last breach of the rule.
