Mr. McFarlane pleaded guilty to the charge. Miss Jay Mac was found guilty and Stewards directed that the greyhound perforn a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1)(a), before any future nomination will be accepted.
