Mr. Late was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr. S. Divers, the trainer of Too Seductive regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Too Seductive last raced on 17/06/15. Mr. Divers stated that greyhound was returning to race after being in season twice. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Too

Seductive trialled over the 500m from box 1, weight 27.3k, the greyhound was placed 2nd in a field of 4.
The time of the trial was 28:26, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 6L. Too Seductive was Cleared.
