Race 1 TAB.COM.AU (250+RANK) 12:02 pm 350m Maiden	Stewards spoke to Ms Jessica Hopkins, the trainer of lona Regis, regarding the length of time the greyhound has had between races. Iona Regis last raced on 14 December 2016 and is returning after an injury to the left stopper and a change of kennel.
	A pre-race sample was taken from Jupiter Asending.
	Alouette Josie and Bad Size were slow to begin.
	Call Me Loulou and Pink Floyd collided soon after the start. Call Me Loulou and Pink Floyd collided at the 300m mark. Bad Size eased at the 250m mark. Bad Size and Jupiter Asending collided at the 150m mark. Bad Size and Call Me Loulou collided approaching the winning post.
	Bad Size was vetted following the event. It was reported that the greyhound sustained no apparent injury and trainer, Mr Gary Sciortino, declined to have the greyhound revetted.
	Stewards spoke to Mr Sciortino, the trainer of the greyhound Bad Size regarding the greyhound's racing manners at the 250m mark. Acting under GAR 69(A)(1) stewards charged Bad Size with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Sciortino pleaded guilty to the charge, Bad Size was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Healesville and it was directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

300m	Ms Ladd, trainer of Miss Houdini, declared a new weight of 29.1kg for the greyhound in accordance with
Maiden	GAR 39(2). Miss Houdini last raced at 27.9kg.
	A pre-race sample was unable to be obtained from Peace On Earth; a post-race sample was subsequently collected.
	Miss Houdini was quick to begin. Alyssa Rose was slow to begin.
	Dee Mini Mouse, Regal Tycoon and Miss Houdini collided soon after the start. Alyssa Rose and Sloan collided soon after the start. Hello Mr Duck and Regal Tycoon collided at the 250m mark, checking Hello Mr Duck. Peace On Earth and Regal Tycoon collided at the 200m mark. Regal Tycoon and Black Lesta collided at the 150m mark. Peace On Earch, Dee Mini Mouse and Miss Houdini collided at the 150m, checking Peace On Earth and Dee Mini Mouse. Peace On Earth checked off Dee Mini Mouse approaching the winning post.

Race 4 RACING HERE FRIDAY APRIL 28TH (250+RANK) 12:57 pm 300m Grade 7 Stewards spoke to Mr Gary Sciortino, the trainer of Urban Enforcer, regarding the length of time the greyhound has had between races. Urban Enforcer last raced on 13 January 2017 and is returning after being seasonal.

A pre-race sample was taken from Urban Enforcer.

Invasion was slow to begin.

Invasion crossed to the outside soon after the start, checking Bernmar Caviar.

Race 5 TAB REWARDS (250+RANK) 1:12 pm 350m Grade 7	A pre-race sample was taken from Miss Flower. Bald Wal and Bryden Peter were slow to begin. Bryden Peter checked off Miss Flower at the 300m mark. Faith No More and Bald Wal collided approaching the 300m mark.
Race 6 SMITH & CALDER SIGN CO (250+RANK) 1:32 pm 350m Grade 5	Stewards spoke to Mr Gary Thorneycroft, the trainer of Rover, regarding the length of time the greyhound has had between races. Rover last raced on 10 January 2017 and is returning after an injury to the left stopper. A pre-race sample was taken from Rover. Phil Miyoot, Boloney Club and Shiro were slow to begin and collided soon after the start. Kerrie's One and Hide The Wallet collided several times between the 50m mark and the winning post. Stewards issued a warning to Mr Alan Maram regarding his failure to catch the greyhound Rover at the conclusion of this event.
Race 7 STRAIGHTS FUNCTIONS & EVENTS (250+RANK) 1:47 pm 350m Mixed 6/7	A pre-race sample was taken from Gats Prodigy. Leaf Spring and Broadcast Ted were slow to begin and collided soon after the start. Ima Terror and Zulu Zoe collided at the 300m mark. Goldenpaw Flyer checked off Bolare at the 250m, checking Gats Prodigy. Rickie Metisse and Bolare collided at the 100m mark, checking Rickie Metisse and Leaf Spring. Stewards noted that soon after the start, the lure became further ahead of the leading greyhounds than the required distance. Stewards were of the opinion that this did not affect the outcome of the race, GAR 55(1). Stewards spoke to lure driver, Mr T Adamson, who advised that he had little experience driving the lure at the Healesville track. Stewards noted his explanation and forwarded the matter to the appropriate persons.

Horey's Pal, Mix Off Harmony and Superior Swagger collided at the 300m mark, checking all three greyhounds. Jack's Pick and Wise Harry collided at the 300m mark. Superior Swagger and Wise Harry collided at the 250m mark, checking Cosmic Spur, Pawesome Boss and Wise Harry. Cosmic Spur and Superior Swagger collided at the 150m mark. Cosmic Spur checked off Superior Swagger at the 50m mark. A sample was taken from Jack's Rainbow, the winner of the event.

Stewards issued a warning to Mr Andrew Saliba, handler of Fiery Nell, regarding his failure to comply with the GRV dress code.

Okay Alpha last raced on 13 January 2017 and is returning after an injury to the right calf. A pre-race sample was taken from Mendacious Lad. Mendacious Lad went up with the lids at box rise and was slow to begin. Okay Alpha was also slow to begin. Okay Alpha and Mendacious Lad collided at the 250m mark. Face To Face crossed to the outside at the 250m mark. Face To Face and Okay Alpha collided at the 100m mark.
Race 11 GAP PROGRAM (250+ RANK) 3:12 pm 300m Mixed 4/5	A pre-race sample Sundance Lad was taken. Fly As One stumbled at box rise and was very slow to begin (4L). Cheetah Stealth and Iron Side were slow to begin. Dontron and Kev's Fantasy collided soon after the start. Star's Big Boy, Cheetah Stealth, Dontron and Kev's Fantasy collided at the 200m mark, checking Cheetah Stealth. Dontron crossed to the rail approaching the 50m mark.
