It was reported that the greyhound sustained injuries an abrasion to the inside right thigh, and a three-day stand down period was imposed. Acting under GAR 69(B)(1), the stewards charged Murrabit Ranger with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Jeffries pleaded guilty to the charge, Murrabit Ranger was found guilty and stewards directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1)(a), before any future nomination will be accepted.

The time of the trial was 22.71, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 23.75L. Fire Boss was not cleared. Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Ms Cassandra Barnard, the trainer of Gaytime Magic, regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced.
