Race 1

3:34 pm 440m Maiden Stilton Harvey was a late scratching at 2:48PM (GAR 31(1)) when it was discovered that trainer Ms Dawn Johnston had presented the incorrect greyhound to stewards at time of kennelling. Ms Johnston was fined the sum of \$250.

Due to a malfunction with the timing device the winning time for this race was amended.

Zipping Danii and Chief Paddy were quick to begin. Vladimir Rose was slow to begin.

Chief Paddy and Sambucca Rose collided soon after the start. Zipping Danii contacted the running rail on the first turn, checking Zipping Danii and Gamber's Loot. Chief Paddy and Sambucca Rose collided on the first turn. Chief Paddy and Sambucca Rose collided several times in the home straight.

It was reported that the greyhound sustained abrasions to the right hind toes, no veterinary stand down period was imposed. Acting under GAR 69(B)(1), the stewards charged Zelemar Cocoa with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Jennings pleaded guilty to the charge, Zelemar Cocoa was found guilty and stewards directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1)(a), before any future nomination will be accepted.
