Meeting Comments

Satisfactory Trial Results (Blinkers) - Big Boy Rocket trialled over the 390m from box 1 weight 31.6kg, the greyhound was placed 5th in a field of 5 starters. The time of the trial was 22.74, the greyhound was beaten/won by a margin of 9.75L. Big Boy Rocket was Cleared and Cleared To Race In Blinkers.

Satisfactory Trial Results - Last Outlaw trialled over the 390m from box 5, weight 32.1kg, the greyhound was placed 1st in a field of 5 starters. The time of the trial was 22.74, the greyhound won by a margin of 4.75L. Last Outlaw was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr Brett Cook, the trainer of Auburn Gal regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Auburn Gal last raced on 8/1/2017. Mr Cook stated that greyhound was returning from a spell. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Auburn Gal trialled over the 390m from box 7, weight 26.1kg, the greyhound was placed 3rd in a field of 5 starters. The time of the trial was 22.74, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 6L. Auburn Gal was Cleared.
