It was reported that the greyhound sustained an injury to the left gracilis (back) muscle, a five-day stand down period was imposed. Acting under GAR 69(B)(1), the stewards charged Derivation with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury) on the home turn. Mr Shaw pleaded not guilty to the charge, Derivation was found guilty and stewards directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial

	(all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1)(a), before any future nomination will be accepted. The Stewards also note their concerns with the racing manners of Derivation in the home straight and issued a warning as a result.
