Satisfactory Trial Results (Blinkers) - Magic Shianne trialled over the 390m from box 1, weight 26.2kg, the greyhound was placed 1st in a field of four starters. The time of the trial was 22.38, the greyhound won by a margin of 8.25 lengths. Magic Shianne was cleared to race with right side blinker only.

Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr K.Bentley, the trainer of Ultimate Impulse regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Ultimate Impulse last raced on 15 February, 2017. Ms Bentley stated that the greyhound was returning from racing after a spell. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Ultimate Impulse trialled over the 390m from box 3, weight 26.7kg, the greyhound was placed 3rd in a field of four starters. The time of the trial was 22.38, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 8.50 lengths. Ultimate Impulse was Cleared.
