Stewards concluded the Inquiry at today's meeting and following all evidence presented, Stewards fined Ms Tamara Cornell the sum of \$100 for failing to catch "Harsh Miles" after being engaged by Mr. Cook to do so in Event 1 at Healesville on 17 September, 2017.
