Mr Hansen pleaded guilty to the charge, Hot Cruiser was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Geelong and it was directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

MEETING COMMMNTS:

Satisfactory Trial Results - Quen Bale trialled over the 400m from box 1, weight 26.9kgs, the greyhound was placed 3rd in a field of 4.The time of the trial was 22.74, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 2 lengths. Quen Bale was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results - Blackpool Remi trialled over the 400m from box 5, weight 26.7kgs, the greyhound was placed 4th in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 22.74, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 12 lengths. Blackpool Remi was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results - I'm Electric trialled over the 400m from box 7, weight 31.7kgs, the greyhound was placed 2nd in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 22.74, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 1.5 lengths. I'm Electric was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results - Slingshot Sassy trialled over the 400m from box 1, weight 25.4kgs, the greyhound was placed 1st in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 22.85, the greyhound won by a margin of 1 length. Slingshot Sassy was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr. Denis Craven, the trainer of Bryden Dora, regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Bryden Dora last raced on 20/7/17. Mr. Craven stated that the greyhound had been seasonal. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Bryden Dora trialled over the 400m from box 3, weight 27.3kgs, the greyhound was placed 3rd in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 22.85, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 4.25 lengths. Bryden Dora was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr. Chris Armstrong, the trainer of Fish Armo, regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Fish Armo last raced on 20/2/17. Mr. Armstrong stated that the greyhound was returning following a spell. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Fish Armo trialled over the 400m from box 5, weight 25.7kgs, the greyhound was placed 4th in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 22.85, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 5.75 lengths. Fish Armo was Cleared.

Supplementary Report – Geelong 16/2/18: Jai Willoughby and Haydn Wilkinson each pleaded guilty to a charge of negligence under GAR. 86(o) for failing to remove the greyhound Ben Roman from the kennel block at the conclusion of the race meeting. Mr. Willoughby and Mr. Wilkinson were each fined \$100. In determining penalty Stewards took into account their forthright evidence and good records in relation to this rule, however were also mindful of the potential welfare implications for greyhounds left on course.
