Flying Queen last race on 22 January, 2018 and is returning to racing following a seasonal spell.</p> <p>A pre-race sample was taken from Hurricane Billie.</p> <p>Marvo Mike and Lil' Miss Willow were slow to begin.</p> <p>Flying Queen and Hurricane Billie collided soon after the start. Flying Queen crossed in on the first turn, checking Bowie Boy. Miss Zok Dee and Elphaba Oz collided approaching the home turn, checking Miss Zok Dee. Little Bala was Cleared. Bekim Instinct trialled over the 400m from box 8, weight 27.8kgs, the greyhound was placed 2nd in a field of 5. The time of the trial was 22.75, he greyhound beaten by a margin of 0.75L. Bekim Instinct was Cleared.
