Satisfactory Trial Results - Shady Whip trialled over the 311m from box one, weight 31.6kg, the greyhound was placed first in a field of five. The time of the trial was 17.90, the greyhound won by a margin of 4.5 lengths. Shady Whip was Cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Ms. Uta Bickerton, the trainer of Pacific Reef regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Pacific Reef last raced on 20th September 2017. Ms. Bickerton stated that the greyhound had a spell and was recovering from a left triangle injury, Pursuant to GAR 77A, Pacific Reef trialled over the 311m from box three, weight 32.1kg, the greyhound was placed fourth in a field of five. The time of the trial was 17.90, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 12.25 lengths. Pacific Reef was Cleared. (Pacific Reef and Brakae collided several times from the first turn to the home turn, causing both greyhounds to lose ground.)

Satisfactory Trial Results - Brakae trialled over the 311m from box five, weight 32.9kg, the greyhound was placed fifth in a field of five. The time of the trial was 17.90, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 13.5 lengths. Brakae was Cleared. (Pacific Reef and Brakae collided several times from the first turn to the home turn, causing both greyhounds to lose ground.)
