The time of the trial was 17.89, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 9 lengths. No Road eased on the first turn and was Not Cleared.</p> <p>Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr J. Collins, the representative of Ziping Bronze regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Ziping Bronze last raced on 2 May 2018 and is returning to racing from injuries to both stopper ligaments. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Ziping Bronze trialled over the 311mtrs from box 4, weight 35.1kgs, the greyhound was placed 1st in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 17.89, the greyhound won by a margin of 2 1/2 lengths. Ziping Bronze was Cleared.</p> <p>Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr D. Franklin, the trainer of Culliquin Panda regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced.
